## I. Update from MWD on Regional Recycled Water Project (Carson Project)

Watermaster staff coordinated a presentation from a Metropolitan Water District (MWD) representative, but due to a scheduling conflict, they were unable to attend. The update has been rescheduled for the June committee meeting.

Mr. Tom Love, General Manager, Upper San Gabriel Valley Municipal Water District (USGVMWD), provided an update from the perspective of an MWD member agency, stating that the pilot project continues, and USGVMWD is coordinating efforts to potentially combine their Indirect Reuse Replenishment Project (IRRP) into the project.

Mr. Tony Zampiello explained that MWD has been working with Watermaster and our consultant, for about a year, modeling the Basin characteristics and its ability to effectively spread the treated effluent from the Carson Project, in the Main Basin.

## II. Other

Mr. Love also provided an update on status of the California WaterFix. He stated that MWD and a group of other State Water Project (SWP) Contractors, have formed a Joint Powers Authority, and are moving forward with design and construction options. He stated that the current plan is to construct two tunnels, and discussions continue between the SWP Contractors and the Central Valley Project Contractors to ensure adequate sizing for full participation.
